Q1. Can a vendor submit multiple solutions? If yes, does each solution need to be submitted individually?

CDCR will accept multiple solutions with the following conditions:

1. Solutions must be submitted in separate emails.
2. "Solution XX", shall represent the corresponding solution number on the *Line-Item Cost Worksheet* or Quote on Company Header, and must also be added to the email's subject line at time of submission.

Please Note: The State has determined the method for awarding this opportunity is, "Lowest Cost"; meaning that the State will award based on the lowest responsive and responsible bidder meeting all administrative and technical requirements, terms, and conditions of this solicitation.

Q2. What are the dimensions of the proposed installation site as the bid only mentions specific scanner dimensions?

Location 1: Approximately 61 feet (L) x 41 feet (W)

Location 2: Approximately 14 feet (L) x 15 feet (W)

Q3. Will these scanners replace existing scanners? If yes, will the new scanners be used in the same space. If yes, does CDCR require removal and disposal of existing units?

Yes, these scanners will replace existing scanners. Yes, these scanners will be used in the same space. No, CDCR does not require removal and disposal of existing units. CDCR will remove the existing units prior to the agreed upon installation date.

Our desire is that appropriately provisioned users will be able to perform ‘administrative’ activities from their desk rather than while standing at the x-ray machine terminal. We define ‘administrative’ activities to include, at a minimum: creation of new user accounts, editing of existing user accounts, generating activity reports, generating radiation dose reports, and exporting scan images.
