PROJECT: City of Social Circle Walton Drive Emergency Repair

This Addendum forms a part of the Contract Documents and Construction Drawings and modifies the original Bid Documents for the above referenced project. Total pages of this addendum is 7 pages.

The following items shall take precedence over the specifications for the above named project and shall become a part of the contract documents.

Clarification:

Please find the attached revised bid package, which has been updated to incorporate all changes outlined in Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

All work shall be completed within 20 calendar days.

Questions

Q1. Is a bid bond required for this project since scope was cut significantly?

A1. No.

Q2. Are contractors responsible for removing and replacing the driveways, sidewalks, and curbs, or are we only restoring them?

A2. Driveways, sidewalks, and curbs disturbed as part of pavement mill and overlay shall be restored. Specific driveways, sidewalks, or curbs may be removed and replaced as directed by the City as part of the Contractor's scope of work.

Q3. Plans mentions cutting the driveway, so assumption is that some removal is required. If so, are we removing and replacing the entire driveway or just parts of it?

A3. Concrete driveways to be cut and repaired shall be removed and replaced to the first joint. If repair extends beyond the first joint, Contractor shall remove and replace to the next joint unless directed otherwise by the City.

Q4. Is a COI required with the bid, or only if the project is awarded? If it is required with the bid, can the City provide the insurance requirements?

A4. COI will be required from awarded contractor.

Q5. On page 2, under subcontractors, it states that all subcontractors must submit a non-collusion affidavit. Can the City provide the required form?

A5. Form will be provided to awarded contractor.

Q6. Just to confirm, the name on the bid documents are Corby Lane, and Emily Lane. The name on google maps is Corby Creek and Emily Drive. Can you please confirm?

A6. See Revised Bid Package.

Q7. Will a proof roll be done after milling is completed?

A7. No.

Q8. Will there be a patching line item added?

A8. No.

Q9. On Walton drive there is a gravel patch down the center of the road, is that supposed to be paved before the street is paved and what line item will that go under?

A9. Contractor shall blade/excavate gravel as required to establish proper grade with milled roadway for full width paving to specified depth with proper road crown. Contractor shall coordinate with City on option for City to save removed material rather than haul off and disposal.

Formal bids will be received by Social Circle for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and any other miscellaneous items necessary for Walton Drive Emergency Repair.

Bids will be received at the City of Social Circle, Attention: Robbie Groves, 166 North Cherokee Road, Social Circle, GA 30025 until 2:00 p.m. local time on Tuesday, June 30, 2026. Any bids received after said time and date of bid opening will not be considered by Owner. Bids will be publicly opened and only the names of the respondents will be read aloud at 2:10 p.m. local time on Tuesday, June 30, 2026 at the of Social Circle City Hall, 166 North Cherokee Road, Social Circle, GA 30025. All bids will be evaluated by the City of Social Circle and the project will be awarded, if it is awarded, within 45 days of the bid opening.

CONTRACTORS and SUBCONTRACTORS quoting on this Project will be required to comply with all Federal, State, and local laws.

The City of Social Circle reserves the right to waive any informalities and to accept any Bid which in its opinion may be in the best interest of Social Circle.

Both a performance and payment bond will be required in the amount equal to 100% of the contract price. Proof of workers compensation and liability insurance will be required with the City of Social Circle named as additional insured.

Proof of workers compensation and liability insurance will be required with the City of Social Circle named as additional insured. Contractor's must also provide a Contractor Affidavit verifying compliance with the Federal Work Authorization Program known as E-Verify. This form must be notarized.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

STATEMENT OF EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS:

The Contractor may be required, upon request, to prove to the satisfaction of the City of Social Circle that he/she has the skill, experience, equipment and the necessary facilities and ample financial resources to perform the contract(s) in a satisfactory manner and within the required time. If the available evidence of competency of any Contractor is not deemed satisfactory, the bid may be rejected.

SUBCONTRACTS:

Contractor is specifically advised that any person, firm or other party to whom it is proposed to award a subcontract must be acceptable to the City of Social Circle. All Subcontractors must submit a Non-Collusion Affidavit.

CHANGE ORDERS:

No oral statement of any person shall modify or otherwise change or affect the terms, conditions or specifications. All change orders to the agreement will be made in writing and shall not be effective unless signed by an authorized representative of the City of Social Circle.

PAVEMENT FINISH:

Milling and asphalt placement shall be performed as directed by the City of Social Circle. Final asphalt finish shall be flush with and match the grade of the existing pavement surface, with a minimum 2% slope away from the centerline or to match existing crown. The final work product shall provide a smooth road surface to safely accommodate traffic. Any irregularities in asphalt material or surface finish shall be corrected by Contractor at no additional cost.

MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT:

All labor, materials, equipment and items specified and incidental to the work shall be included in the unit price bids as defined below. A 5% retainage will be withheld on all monthly pay requests until final project completion.

WALTON DRIVE EMERGENCY REPAIR

ITEM 1 – MILL ASPHALT PAVEMENT, 2 INCH DEPTH

The basis of payment for this item shall be square yard (SY); including all labor, equipment and materials required to mechanically mill, remove, haul and dispose of asphalt pavement to be replaced as shown or indicated in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.

ITEM 2 – ASPHALT PAVING – 12.5MM SUPERPAVE

The basis of payment for this item shall be per ton (TN); including all labor, equipment and materials required for subgrade preparation, asphalt placement and compaction in accordance with Georgia DOT Standards.

ITEM 3 – CONCRETE DRIVEWAY CUT & REPAIR

The basis of payment for this item shall be square yard (SY) including all labor, equipment and materials required to cut and repair driveway as shown or indicated in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.

ITEM 4 – CONCRETE SIDEWALK RESTORATION

The basis of payment for this item shall be square yard (SY) including all labor, equipment and materials required to complete concrete sidewalks restoration to match the existing indicated in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.

ITEM 5 – PERMANENT SEEDING (DS3)

The basis of payment for this item shall be in linear foot (LF) including all labor, equipment and materials required to complete the process of permanent seeding for site.

ITEM 6 – SOD RESTORATION (DS4)

The basis of payment for this item shall be in square foot (SF) including all labor, equipment and materials required to complete the process of sod restoration to match existing present before emergency repair for site.

ITEM 7 – CONCRETE CURB & GUTTER REPLACEMENT

The basis of payment for this item shall be per linear foot, by type, including subgrade preparation, formwork, finishing, expansion joints, and all incidental labor, equipment, and materials required for installation to match existing as shown or indicated in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.

ITEM 8 – TRAFFIC CONTROL

The basis of payment for this item shall be per lump sum (LS); including all labor, materials, equipment required to provide work zone traffic control including signage, barrels, cones, flagmen, and pedestrian safety measures in accordance with Georgia DOT Standards. Any proposed temporary road closures or detours must be approved in advance by Social Circle.

PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS

Scope of Work:

Walton Drive Emergency Repair: The Contractor shall provide all labor, equipment, materials and any other miscellaneous items necessary for asphalt milling to a depth of 2", traffic control, cleanup, surface prep, tack coat, 12.5mm asphalt resurfacing, concrete driveway repair, site restoration.

Project Management/Inspections: Project management and inspection will be provided by the Social Circle Public Works Department and/or Precision Planning, Inc.

Schedule: All work shall be completed within 20 calendar days from the date of Notice to Proceed. Prior to commencing the work, the Contractor shall provide a written schedule to Social Circle Public Works regarding the sequence/order of the work. The Contract shall include a provision for liquidated damages to be assessed at the rate of \$500 per calendar day for late completion. This is a residential neighborhood and work shall be done from 8:00 am – 6:00 pm.

Traffic Control: Contractor shall be responsible for Traffic Control, in accordance with Georgia DOT Standards, and shall provide all signage, personnel and miscellaneous equipment to maintain alternating single lane traffic while work is being conducted and normal two lane traffic when personnel are not on site. The Social Circle Public Works Department must approve any proposed temporary road closures under this contract, and if approved, the Contractor shall be responsible for establishing required signage and maintaining acceptable detour routes during the construction period.

Safety: Contractor shall be responsible for jobsite safety, and the safety of the traveling and general public within the work zone.

Access/Cleanup/Disposal: Contractor shall be responsible for coordinating access to private property during the execution of the work, and for cleanup of any millings or debris resulting from the project on adjacent private property or within public right-of-way. The Contractor shall remove, haul and dispose of all asphalt millings at an approved facility.
