

**DOUGLAS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL
FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEM
Solicitation No. 26-019**

Douglas County (“Owner” or the “County”) is issuing this Request for Proposal (“RFP”) to solicit commercial and technical proposals (“Proposals”) from qualified bidders (“Respondents”) for the design, fabrication, and installation of fire suppression systems at the following locations:

- **Douglas County DOT Maintenance Complex**
8251 Chicago Avenue
Douglasville, GA 30134
- **Douglas County Sheriff’s Department Complex**
8470 Earl D. Lee Boulevard
Douglasville, GA 30134 (collectively, the “Project”).

Capitalized terms used in this RFP and not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Agreement for the Project (“Agreement”). Respondents are encouraged to review all included bidding and contract documents for the complete scope of work and project requirements.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at 2PM on June 10, 2026 at the Douglas County DOT Maintenance Complex located at 8251 Chicago Avenue, Douglasville, Georgia 30134. Immediately following the meeting at this location, attendees will proceed to the Douglas County Sheriff’s Department Complex located at 8470 Earl D. Lee Boulevard, Douglasville, Georgia 30134 for the second site visit.

Responses to this Invitation to Bid must be received electronically through the Douglas County BidNet online bidding platform no later than July 2, 2026, at 2:00 P.M. Eastern Time. No other County staff, officials, or representatives associated with this Project shall be contacted regarding this solicitation. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in the bidder’s disqualification.

Douglas County reserves the right to waive informalities and irregularities, reject any or all bids, evaluate bids as deemed appropriate, accept portions of any bid, and award the contract in the best interest of the County. The County further reserves the right to add to or delete from the contract scope after award, as necessary.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days following the bid opening. All bids shall remain firm and valid during this period.

No bid will be accepted after the stated deadline. Any bid received after the designated date and time shall be deemed non-responsive and returned unopened to the bidder.
