TECHNICAL QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- 1) **Question:** Can you tell me what courses are necessary for the RISC contract? I see in the proposal a 4-hour training is necessary but, when you log into the National Traffic Incident Management site, it has over 30 modules.

Answer: The certified training courses are as follows:

Intermediate MOT course: For individuals looking to complete Intermediate or Advanced Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) training in Florida, there are multiple FDOT-approved agencies that offer this training statewide. You can find certified training providers and upcoming class schedules by visiting the **Florida Department of Transportation** training portal at https://www.motadmin.com/find_course/. From here, you will just select the specific course, location, and date to see any upcoming classes.
