ITN TITLE: RAPID INCIDENT SCENE CLEARANCE (RISC) SERVICES FOR DISTRICT SEVEN.

Notice is hereby given of the following changes to the above-referenced ITN:

1. CHANGE: EXHIBIT “B”, METHOD OF COMPENSATION, SECTION 2.4:

REPLACE THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE:

Vendors called for a “Non-Vehicle” RISC activation will be placed at the bottom of the rotation list, similar to a standard RISC activation for that county/zone. “Non-Vehicle Incident Clearance” payments are one-time payments and do not include any additional or grouped payments as outlined in sections 2.1., 2.2., and 2.3.

WITH:

Non-Vehicular RISC Activation: Non-Vehicular RISC incident activations do not operate under a separate rotation list. Instead, the vendor next in line on the established RISC rotation list for the designated area of coverage where the incident occurs will be activated to respond.

Impact of Declination on Rotation Position: If a vendor declines a non-vehicular RISC activation, the vendor’s position on the RISC rotation list will be impacted, and the vendor will be moved to the bottom of the rotation list. Conversely, acceptance and successful completion of a non-vehicular RISC activation will not affect the vendor’s position on the rotation list.

Non-Vehicular Incident Clearance Payment: Payments for non-vehicular RISC activations are one-time payments and will not include any additional or grouped payments as specified in Sections 2.1, 2.2, and 2.3 of this Contract.

Repliers must acknowledge receipt of this Addendum by completing and returning it to the Procurement Office, by no later than the time and date of the bid opening. **Failure to do so may subject the repplier to disqualification.**
