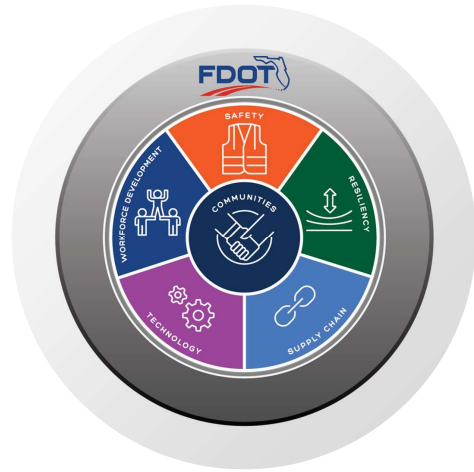

Estimated Schedule & Costs*

Design – Fall 2026

- Cost: \$1.6 million

Right of Way – Within Existing

Construction – Spring 2027

- Cost: \$9.7 million

Design for this project is expected to finish in fall 2026 at an estimated cost of \$1.6 million. All improvements will be built within the existing right of way. Construction is anticipated to begin in spring 2027 with an estimated cost of \$9.7 million.

What to Expect During Construction
