

# S.R. A1A Safety Improvements

## From Milsap Road to Granada Boulevard (S.R. 40)

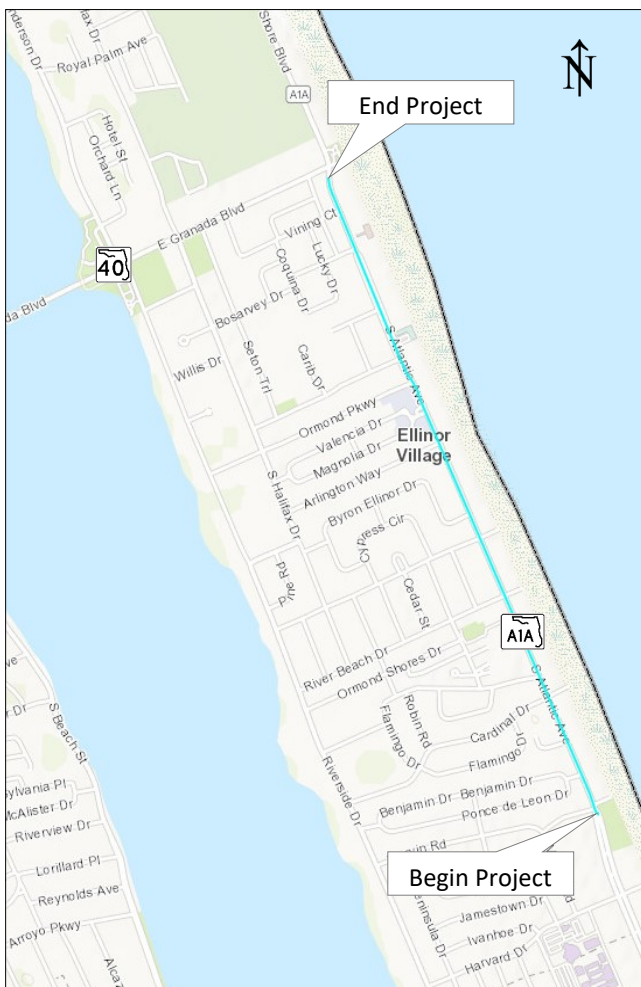


### Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is designing this project to improve traffic operations and safety along State Road (S.R.) A1A by implementing access management improvements within the center turn lane. The project emerged from the 2018 S.R. A1A Access Management Study from Milsap Road to Granada Boulevard (S.R. 40) in Ormond Beach.

The project would construct a raised median with directional median openings at Milsap Road, Wren Road, the Ellinor Village shopping center, just south of Florida Avenue, River Beach Drive, Rockefeller Drive, north of Byron Elinor Drive, Arlington Way, Ormond Parkway, Seminole Approach Beach Ramp, Osceola Avenue, Bosarvey Drive and Vining Court. Full median openings would remain at the City of Ormond Beach Fire Department and Cardinal Drive.

The project also calls for creating new pedestrian crossings at River Beach Drive, Rockefeller Drive, Arlington Way, Seminole Avenue beach approach, Osceola Avenue and Bosarvey Drive.

The FDOT invites interested persons to a public hearing regarding the proposed improvements on Thursday, December 3, 2020. The Department is offering multiple ways to learn about the project and provide comment.

The Department is offering multiple ways for the community to participate in the hearing. All participants, regardless of platform they choose, will participate in the same live hearing.

- **Virtual Option:** Interested persons may join the Virtual Public Hearing (VPH) from a computer, tablet or mobile device. A VPH is a free live presentation or webinar over the internet. For this option, advance registration is required by visiting the link below. Once registered, participants will receive a confirmation email containing information about joining the hearing online. At this time, Internet Explorer is not supported by GoToWebinar, and the link for the hearing will not work on this platform. - **Phone Option (Listen-Only):** Participants may also join the hearing in listen-only mode by dialing 1-877-309-2071 and entering the passcode 791-322-777 when prompted. Please note, while the call-in number is listen-only, callers may submit comments directly to the project manager by using the contact information listed below.
- **In-Person Option:** Interested persons may participate in person by going to the Ormond Beach Performing Arts Center at 399 N. U.S. 1, Ormond Beach, Florida 32174. For this option, the Department requests advance registration by contacting the project manager to ensure all attendees are accommodated safely and according to social distancing guidelines. Attendees will be asked to follow safety guidelines and adhere to any local ordinances. Those who are not feeling well should not attend in person.

The VPH and in-person hearing location open at 6 p.m. A presentation will begin promptly at 6:10 p.m., followed by a formal public comment period. If joining online, please provide adequate log-in time to view the presentation in its entirety.

All hearing materials, including the presentation, will be available on the project website prior to the hearing. A recording of the hearing will be posted within a week of the meeting.
