The assay must be able to test whole blood, serum, plasma, and in-house validated oral fluid to conform to the CDC 2014 HIV Diagnostic Algorithm guidelines. In accordance with Chapter 60A-1.045, Florida Administrative Code, the Florida Department of Health, BPHL, requests authorization to purchase, as a single source, the Bio-Rad Laboratories Geenius™ System assays and controls.

- The Geenius™ System is the only FDA approved HIV-1/HIV-2 differential assay currently on the U.S. market and has been validated in-house for the confirmation of HIV-1 Oral Fluid meeting the guidelines required.
- Bio-Rad Laboratories (manufacturer) is the sole distributor of the Geenius™ System.
