The Bureau of Radiation Control must comply with Source Collection and Threat Reduction (SCATR) program to dispose of sealed sources of unused radioactive sources of radiation. In accordance with Chapter 60A-1.045, Florida Administrative Code, The Bureau of Radiation Control Environmental Section requests authorization to purchase as a single source, disposal and removal services of radioactive sources from Bionomics, Inc.

Justification for single source acquisition (what is necessary and unique about the product, services or source; steps taken to confirm unavailability of competition, as appropriate):

- The Federal Department of Energy's NNSA has contracted with the Conference of Radiation Control Program Director (CRCPD) to run the Source Collection and Threat Reduction (SCATR) disposal of sealed sources of radiation program.
- The CRCPD has contracted Bionomics, Inc. to collect the radioactive sources disposed of through the SCATR Program. To receive the SCATR discount participants must use Bionomics, Inc., as the broker to collect and dispose of the radioactive sources.
