**1. PROJECT**

**1.1. Overview**

- 1.1.1. Nevada Department of Public Safety-State Police is seeking quotes from qualified vendors to provide biohazard cleanup services as described in the scope of work.
- 1.1.2. The State intends to award one contract in conjunction with this informal solicitation, as determined in the best interests of the State. Nevada Department of Public Safety-State Police shall administer contract resulting from this solicitation. The resulting contract are expected to be for a contract term of (4) years.

- 3.1.2. Quotes shall be consistently evaluated and scored based upon the following factors and relative weights.
  - A. Technical Factor #1 – Mobilization/Demobilization Capabilities, Experience.....20
  - B. Technical Factor #2 – Biohazard/Non-biohazard Cleanup & Disposal Certifications & Qualifications .....20
  - C. Technical Factor #3 – Response Times & Availability .....20
  - D. Technical Factor #4 – Waste Transport & Disposal .....10
  - E. Technical Factor #5 – Reporting and Documentation Capabilities.....10

**4. MANDATORY MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

- 4.1. Pursuant to NRS 333.311 a contract cannot be awarded to a vendor that does not comply with the requirements listed in this section. By submitting a quote, vendor confirms compliance with all mandatory minimum requirements.
- 4.2. **Nevada Law and State indemnity.** Pursuant to [NRS 333.339](#), any contract that is entered into may not: (1) require the filing of any action or the arbitration of any dispute that arises from the contract to be instituted or heard in another state or nation; or (2) require the State to indemnify another party against liability for damages.
- 4.3. **No Boycott of Israel.** Pursuant to [NRS 333.338](#), the State of Nevada cannot enter a contract with a company unless that company agrees for the duration of the contract not to engage in a boycott of Israel. By submitting a response, vendor agrees that if it is awarded a contract, it will not engage in a boycott of Israel as defined in [NRS 333.338\(3\)\(a\)](#).
- 4.4. **Nevada business license.** Pursuant to [NRS 353.007](#), prior to contract execution awarded vendor must hold a state business license pursuant to [NRS chapter 76](#) unless exempted by [NRS 76.100\(7\)\(b\)](#). Business license must match [nevadaepro.com](http://nevadaepro.com) vendor registration.
