General Questions, Clarifications & Requirements:

1. Q: The solicitation does not specify the number of mobilizations anticipated for this project. Work spans 7 separate street locations. Should bidders anticipate a single mobilization with all locations completed sequentially, or multiple separate mobilizations? Please clarify the expected number so we can price the mobilization line item accurately.

A: We have had some vendors just give us a lump sum for mobilization for the entire contract and others break it down per location. The contract time will be 3 months, so as long as everything is installed within those 3 months you can mobilize as much as you need to. It is up to you how you schedule the work.

2. Q: The solicitation requires the contractor to haul removed speed cushions and debris to an "approved public landfill." Can the City confirm: (a) whether dump fees are the contractor's responsibility or will be reimbursed by the City, and (b) which specific landfill(s) are approved for disposal under this contract?

A: Dump fees are the contractor's responsibility. There is not a specific landfill that needs to be used.

3. Q: The bid documents said the time allowed in the road is 9am-4pm. Is that on all streets, or just the roads with a painted center line?

A: That is all roadways.

4. Q: When an old cushion is removed, will the contractor be required to patch back, seal or remove the sleeves from the old anchors? What is the scope there?

A: You can just leave as is.

5. During what hours will the cushions be available for pickup **7am-5pm?**

A: 7:00 AM – 3:30 PM

6. I would assume that the cushions come packaged 1 cushion per pallet. Will someone be available to load, or will we need to plan on hand loading them at the storage facility?

A: No, the cushions are divided up on pallets with like pieces on the same pallet. They can be loaded with a forklift if you have a large enough, capacity-weighted flatbed trailer; otherwise, the bidding party is responsible for loading the individual cushions needed for the job. The contractor can also load the pieces needed for a set, then return to pick up another set when moving to a new location.
