This Addendum is to provide answers to questions submitted by Contractors concerning the Sykes St. Paving Restoration.

Addenda #01 consists of 2 pages:

Question:

1. Article 3.02 states that a Bid may be considered non-responsive if the Bidder cannot demonstrate the ability to complete a majority of the Contract with equipment and personnel owned and employed by the Bidder. To ensure we properly understand the solicitation requirements, we are requesting additional information regarding OWASA's expectations for self-performance by the prime contractor and the use of specialty subcontractors for paving, milling, trucking, traffic control, pavement markings, and related construction activities.

Answer: The intent of Article 3.02 is to ensure that the prime contractor possesses the workforce, equipment resources, experience, and overall capability necessary to successfully perform and manage the Project and is not acting primarily as a pass-through entity that subcontracts substantially all aspects of the Work.

OWASA recognizes that contractors may utilize subcontractors for portions of the Work, including paving, milling, trucking, traffic control, pavement markings, and other specialty or supporting activities. The use of subcontractors is permitted.

The Bidder shall remain fully responsible for the performance of all Work, including work performed by subcontractors.
