- The following are questions received about the Solicitation and the State's response to those questions:

Question #	Document Section	Vendor Question	State's Response
1	Section 1.0	Are the four facilities currently receiving on-site optometry services, and have those services been provided by a single vendor or multiple vendors?	Three (3) of the four facilities are currently receiving on-site Optometry services. A single vendor has provided these services. The fourth (4 th) facility was not added due to the current vendor retiring.
2	Section 1.0	Is there a specific reason the four facilities are being combined under a single contract this cycle, as opposed to per-facility solicitations?	Due to the current contract covering three (3) of the four (4) facilities by a single vendor. The State prefers standardization due to the same service being needed at all four facilities.

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3	Section 5.2	Approximately how many patients are expected to be seen per clinic at each facility? Census figures are provided but not anticipated optometry volume.	<p>Murdoch – sends approximately 8-10 patients per clinic, 180-220 patients per year taking into consideration of cancellations or refusals.</p> <p>Cherry – sends approximately 10 patients per clinic (once a month).</p> <p>Central Regional – Approximately 10 patients per clinic to also include the patients from MDC. CRH patients at 30-Minute increments and 10 pre-dilated Murdoch patients at 15-Minute increments.</p> <p>Broughton – Historically an average of 16-20 patients per month; 8-10 patients must be seen monthly, and majority of patients will need an annual exam.</p>
4	Section 5.2 (10)	Is the Vendor responsible for supplying eyeglasses (frames and lenses), or only for prescribing and fitting, with the facility procuring eyewear separately?	Vendor is not responsible for supplying eyeglasses, frames, or lenses. Vendor shall only prescribe Rx's and fittings of eyeglasses.
