If not, where can it be found? Thank you. A: The Due Diligence Third-Party Information Security Questionnaire is provided under the "Attachments" Tab in NJSTART.
56	Section 6.7 Privacy	Q: Would the State be amenable to modifying the language in Section 6.7Gb to something along the lines of the below, as it is not feasible to fulfil the requirement of having one individual available for 24 hours per day, seven days a week? designate a single contact number and email of a Security Operations Center (SOC) monitored by Contractor which shall be available to the State 24 hours per day, seven (7) days per week as a contact regarding Contractor's obligations under Bid Solicitation Section 6.34 A: The State does not accept this proposed modification. Terms and conditions on publicly bid procurements must be consistent for all potential Bidders, and cannot be based on a single vendor's terms.
57	Section 6.7 Privacy	Q: Would the State be amenable to adjusting the language in Section 6.7Ge to include the language in italics? Certain products sold exist on a shared system and as a result it would be impracticable to impose one customer's instructions on other customers in the event of a breach. (e) follow all instructions provided by the State relating to the Personal Data affected or potentially affected by the Breach of Security, to the extent that it protects the privacy, security, and confidentiality of other customers and does not conflict with other customer instructions or the law. A: The State does not accept this proposed modification. Terms and conditions on publicly bid procurements must be consistent for all potential Bidders, and cannot be based on a single vendor's terms.
58	Section 6.7 Privacy	Q: In Section 6.7E, the State prohibits the transfer of State data outside of the US, but in some instances of support (ex. Certain levels of tech support), the support is provided outside of the United State which requires the sharing of the State data in order to troubleshoot any issues that the customer encounters. Is the State willing to provide approval to share State data outside of the US for these support services?

Data Re-Use: All State Data shall be used expressly and solely for the purposes enumerated in the Contract Data shall not be distributed, repurposed or shared across other applications, environments, or business units of the Contractor, except to the extent it is required for the following: (1) perform services and provide products, (2) analyze to operate, maintain, manage, and improve products and services, and (3) create new products and services. No State Data shall be transmitted, exchanged or otherwise passed to other contractors or interested parties except on a case-by-case basis as specifically agreed to in writing by the State Contract Manager. A: The State does not accept this proposed modification. Terms and conditions on publicly bid procurements must be consistent for all potential Bidders, and cannot be based on a single vendor's terms.
60	Section 6.26 Vulnerability and Patch Management	Q: Would the State be amenable to removing "employing qualified third parties to" in Section 6.26D as shown below? Employing qualified third-parties to periodically conduct Independent vulnerability scanning, penetration testing, and red-team exercises. A: The State does not accept this proposed modification. Terms and conditions on publicly bid procurements must be consistent for all potential Bidders, and cannot be based on a single vendor's terms.
61	Section 5.7 Authorized Dealers and/or Distributors	Q: Is there a limit to the amount of times we may update our dealer list under an awarded contract provided written approval from the state has been obtained? A: Pursuant to Page 2 of Bid Amendment #3, only questions related to the revisions made in response to the first round of Q&A can be addressed at this time. Please be advised that this question is unrelated to any first round Q&A revisions, and is ineligible to be answered at this time.
