30	Section 1.1 – Purpose and Intent	Q: Will an Electrical License meet the requirement of a Burglar License? A: The Electrical Contractors License supersedes the burglar/security licenses.
31	Section 1.1 – Purpose and Intent	Q: NJ Administrative Code, Title 13, Law and Public Safety, Chapter 31A: Fire Alarm, Burglar Alarm and Locksmith Advisory Committee Code states that “Electrical contractors licensed by the Board pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-1 et seq., and their employees while performing the duties of their employment, as set forth in N.J.S.A. 45:5A-29(b)” are exempt from the provisions of this code. Please confirm that an electrical contractor license issued by the State of New Jersey overrides the requirement of a burglar alarm license. A: Yes, the Electrical Contractors License supersedes the burglar/security licenses.
32	Section 4.3.2.1 – Normal Service	Q: In reference to the answer for question #14 for section 4.3.2.1 normal service, the question was not answered. Some services are not covered under the prevailing wage act. Will there be a separate line item for services that do not fall under the prevailing wage act? A: There will not be a separate line item added. The New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act, N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25 et seq., is made part of every contract entered into on behalf of the State of New Jersey. Any work performed must be conducted in accordance with New Jersey law and the specific facts at the time the work is performed.
33	Other	Q: If this contract will fall under the authority of the Director of the DPMC why is it not a requirement for all bidders to have a DPMC Contractor Classification? Is it not a legal requirement and/or would it not be in the State's and public's best interest to be assured of a higher degree of vetting of contractor qualifications and experience? A: It is not a legal requirement of this Bid Solicitation, as this work is primarily related to upgrades and maintenance services.
