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Please be advised of the following changes to the above-mentioned solicitation:

I. **Questions and Answers:** The following are questions received from Vendors and responses from the Illinois Tollway pursuant to the question-and-answer portion of the above-mentioned solicitation. The Illinois Tollway has provided its answers accordingly.

1. **Question:** Do I have to be registered with the Board of Elections prior to bid submission?

**Answer:** Yes, State Board of Elections requirement: Any Bidder with bids/proposals, including this submission, or current contracts totaling over \$50,000.00 must be registered with the Board of elections <https://www.elections.il.gov/>

2. **Question:** Do I need to be registered with the Secretary of State if I am registered in my own State?

**Answer:** Bidder must be legal entity at time of submission but must be registered with the Secretary of State for Illinois prior to contract execution, unless bidder is exempt under Business Contracts Act. [https://www.ilsos.gov/departments/business\\_services/home.html](https://www.ilsos.gov/departments/business_services/home.html)

3. **Question:** Do I need to have an IDHR number?

**Answer:** Yes, Bidder must have the IDHR # if firm has 15 or more employees. <https://www2.illinois.gov/dhr/Pages/default.aspx>

4. **Question:** There is an attachment entitled BEP Utilization plan. I am not familiar with this. Will we need to complete this form as well?

**Answer:** Please refer to section **A.21 BUSINESS ENTERPRISE FOR MINORITIES, WOMEN, AND PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES ACT PARTICIPATION AND UTILIZATION PLAN** of the IFB document. The BEP Goal is 5% and the VET Goal is 1%, therefore a BEP Utilization Plan and a VET Utilization Plan are both required. Refer to the Attachments Tab in BidBuy.

5. **Question:** What is the max height of the cranes at each location or the height of each crane in general? Will a lift be required to inspect?

**Answer:** A lift will be needed; we do not provide the lift needed. The bridge cranes at the m-sites are 27 feet off the deck and the jib crane is 20 feet off the deck.
