SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:

Individuals and firms interested in providing professional services for the above major categories should include the following:

- ☐ 1. A Response Form (see Attachment 1) must be completed for each major category and the selection box(es) marked to indicate the major/subcategory of interest with your submittal.
- ☐ 2. A Statement of Qualifications must be submitted for **each** major category and must include:
 - Background description of the firm and related experience of the principals and key staff members.
 - Education, training, and professional qualifications of key members of the firm.
 - Client references – names, telephone numbers, and email addresses of up to five clients who may be contacted, including at least two for whom services were rendered during the preceding year.
- ☐ 3. Any promotional or descriptive literature which the firm desires to submit.
- ☐ 4. A signed, self-certification statement that the firm is not debarred or suspended.

Submittal packets will only be accepted via the email address listed above.

Submittal packets received after the specified deadline will not be accepted and/or returned to the submitter. Hard copy submittals received via facsimile and mail will not be accepted.

Selection of qualified professionals will be made in accordance with the selection criteria as provided in Section 103D-304(e), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

At the time of award, the selected vendor is required to provide a tax clearance certificate from the State of Hawaii, Department of Taxation, and the Internal Revenue Service; Certificate of Compliance from the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations; and Certificate of Good Standing from the Business Registration Division of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs. In lieu of paper certificates referenced above, vendors may register online through Hawaii Compliance Express and submit the single electronic "Certificate of Vendor Compliance" with a current compliance status.
