INTRODUCTION: NASPO ValuePoint is a cooperative purchasing program facilitating public procurement solicitations and agreements using a lead state model. The National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) is a cooperative group contracting consortium for State government departments, institutions, agencies, and political subdivisions (i.e. colleges, school districts, counties, cities, etc.) for the fifty states, the District of Columbia, and the organized US territories. NASPO is a non-profit association dedicated to strengthening the procurement community through education, research, and communications.

The objective of cooperative groups is to obtain volume price discounts based on the collective volume of the numerous potential purchases by the individual States and their various governmental entities. The benefits of cooperative procurements are the potential administrative and contract management savings realized by contractors from their administration and management of a single, comprehensive NASPO contract, rather than multiple contracts for various State governments and governmental entities. Concurrently, the various State governmental entities also realize these same administrative and management benefits.

This Request for Proposals (RFP) is being issued by the State of New Mexico (“Lead State”) in collaboration with the NASPO ValuePoint cooperative purchasing program. The purpose of this RFP is to re-solicit the Temporary Employment Services portfolio, that is currently set to expire in August 2027, and provide a nationwide cooperative contract that participating entities can use to obtain temporary staffing services through a Managed Service Provider (MSP) model.

The resulting Master Agreement contract(s) for the new Temporary Employment Services Portfolio will include the following categories:

1. Administrative: Provides temporary office, clerical, customer service, and administrative support personnel.
2. Commercial & Industrial: Provides temporary labor, warehouse, manufacturing, logistics, and other industrial workforce personnel.
3. Educational: Provides temporary educational, instructional, and academic support personnel.
4. Healthcare: Provides temporary clinical and non-clinical healthcare professionals and support staff.
5. Information Technology: Provides temporary IT professionals and technical support personnel for technology-related services.
6. Professional Services (Non-IT): Provides temporary professional personnel such as accounting, finance, HR, procurement, management, and consulting staff.
