INTRODUCTION: Sourcewell is a State of Minnesota local government unit and service cooperative created under the laws of the State of Minnesota (Minnesota Statutes Section 123A.21) that facilitates a competitive public solicitation and contract award process for the benefit of its 50,000+ participating entities across the United States and Canada. Sourcewell's solicitation process complies with State of Minnesota law and policies, conforms to Canadian trade agreements, and results in cooperative purchasing solutions from which Sourcewell's Participating Entities procure equipment, products, and services.

Cooperative purchasing provides participating entities and suppliers increased administrative efficiencies and the power of combined purchasing volume that result in overall cost savings. At times, Sourcewell also partners with other purchasing cooperatives to combine the purchasing volume of their membership into a single solicitation and contract expanding the reach of contracted suppliers' potential pool of end users.

Sourcewell, a State of Minnesota local government unit and service cooperative, is requesting proposals Airfield Runway Materials, Services, and Related Solutions, to include FAA and/or DOD compliant equipment and related supplies and services for the primary purpose of airfield repair, maintenance, and related activities including but not limited to:

1. Airfield marking materials and supplies such as paints, thermoplastics, and glass beads;
2. Liquid or solid airfield deicer, and deicing services;
3. Rubber removal agents;
4. Firefighting agents such as aqueous film-forming foam (AFFF), alcohol-resistant AFFF (AR-AFFF), fluorine-free foam (F3), alcohol-resistant fluorine-free foam (AR-F3), biobased/soy-based fluorine-free foam, Purple K and Halotron;
5. Transition-related services used by airfields and other agencies such as risk assessment, planning, engineering, consulting, design, implementation, legacy AFFF/AR-AFFF removal and foam system cleanout, PFAS-containing material handling, storage, transportation, disposal and/or destruction, environmental remediation, system modification, testing, compliance documentation, and certification support.

Sourcewell anticipates that the term of any resulting contract(s) will be four years, with up to three additional one-year extensions that may be offered based on the best interests of Sourcewell and its Participating Entities. Sourcewell retains the right to consider additional extensions beyond seven years as required under exceptional circumstances.
