INVITATION TO BID

CENTRAL MAUI LANDFILL  
PHASE II, STAGE 6 PARTS 2A AND 2B AND 7 SLOPE IMPROVEMENTS  
COUNTY IFB No. 25-26/P-170  
MAUI, HAWAII

Pursuant to Chapter 103D, HRS, sealed bids for the following construction project: **“CENTRAL MAUI LANDFILL PHASE II, STAGE 6 AND 7 SLOPE IMPROVEMENTS, COUNTY IFB No. 25-26 / P-170”**, will be submitted via the web-based Public Purchase System. Bids must be submitted no later than **2:00 PM** Hawaiian Standard time, on **July 9, 2026**. Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud immediately thereafter. Bids not submitted via the Public Purchase System or bids received after the fixed time deadline will not be considered.

This project will primarily consist of constructing slope improvements consisting of compacted low permeability soil liner, lateral drainage layer, protective cover soil layer, and a geosynthetic rain cap on the Stage 6 area of the Phase II slope an area of approximately 2.1 acres. The Stage 7 area slope improvements, over an area of approximately 1.9 acres, are an alternate bid item consisting of the same construction tasks as Stage 7. Construction of the slope improvements will include demolition of existing AC lined drainage ditch, excavation, grading, exposure of existing final cover low permeability soil layer where existing grade must be adjusted to no less than 10%, construction of low permeability soil liner, and placement of lateral drainage layer, protective cover soil, and a geosynthetic rain cap.

The project work area is immediately adjacent to the active disposal area Phase III of the Central Maui Landfill. The Contractor will be responsible to coordinate and sequence all aspects of construction that could affect landfill operations to ensure minimal impact to access and ability to efficiently carry out landfill operations throughout the construction period.

Completion of this project within Contract Time is critically important to the County to avoid exhaustion of available disposal capacity and exposure to potentially significant regulatory penalties.

The Contractor may propose to perform construction outside the normal operating hours of the Central Maui Landfill to facilitate efficient construction, maintain continuous operation of the landfill, and ensure project completion within the Contract Time.

Prospective Bidders and all parties interested in accessing the project plans, specifications, terms and conditions, proposal, and addenda must be registered as a Public Purchase Vendor, Hawaii Region, County of Maui Agency.

Bidders must be qualified in compliance with Section 103D-310 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Bidders shall be licensed in accordance to Chapter 444, HRS, relating to the licensing of Contractors. Bidders shall at a minimum possess a C-17 or C-27 Specialty Contractors License.

The Contractor, and his subcontractor(s), if any, shall comply with all applicable revisions of the law relative to the Prevailing Wage Schedule, as required under Chapter 104, HRS.


A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be conducted for the project. Interested parties are to meet at the **CENTRAL MAUI LANDFILL OFFICE, One Pulehu Road, Puunene, Maui, Hawaii on June 17, 2026 at 10:00 AM** Hawaii Standard Time. After the meeting, interested parties will be invited to meet at the Central Maui Landfill, for a tour of the facility. Interested parties requesting to attend the meeting are required to provide notification of attendance by email to [Solid.Waste@co.maui.hi.us](mailto:Solid.Waste@co.maui.hi.us) at least **THREE (3) days** prior to the designated date.

While attendance to the pre-bid meeting is not mandatory, bidders are strongly encouraged to attend both the pre-bid meeting and site visit, as the scope of this work requires significant familiarity of the existing site conditions.

No proposal will be considered unless accompanied by one of the following forms of bidder's security: cash, a cashier's check, a certified check on a bank insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, or a bidder's bond executed by an approved surety insurer, made payable to the County of Maui in the manner, form, and amount required in Section 103D-323 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes. The proposal guaranty shall be equal to at least five percent (5%) of the total of the bid submitted.

Bidders must correctly prepare and submit the documents listed in Section 00300, Proposal.
