This addendum is to clarify responses to Questions 18 and 19.

Question No. 18: Page 2-12, Section 3, Health Care, Specialty Care Payment Responsibility - This section references the Applicant's responsibility to provide access to specialty and subspecialty care (e.g., cardiology, oncology, gastroenterology) onsite or via community partnerships. Will the State please clarify whether the costs associated with offsite specialty consultations, diagnostics, procedures, or treatments are the responsibility of the State or the Applicant?

Response No. 18: ~~Yes.~~ It is a cost to the Applicant, and the cost should be included in the Applicant's per diem cost.

Question No. 19: Page 2-13, Section 3, Health Care. High-Cost Specialty Medications/Pharmacy Carve-Outs - This section references continuity of care for pre-existing Hawaii consults and specialty referrals. Will the State please clarify whether the Applicant is expected to assume full financial responsibility for follow-up on these pre-existing consults, or will the State cover costs for medically necessary procedures already prescribed or pending prior to transfer?
