B. Remaining Questions and Answers (13)

Q1: Regarding **Addendum No. 5, Question 7**, we are seeking technical clarification on the interpretation of the "same company" requirement for laboratory-based drug testing. Our facility performs on-site specimen collection. Could you confirm if utilizing a long-standing, HHS-certified laboratory partner for the analysis—provided there is a seamless, integrated chain of custody—satisfies the requirement that the collection site and laboratory analysis be conducted "by the same company"?

A1: The specimens collection and analysis can be performed by the same company as long as the collectors are DOT certified and the lab is HHS-certified.

Q2: Additionally, to ensure our staffing and equipment for **Transit Officer Physicals** (MPO-210/211) are perfectly scaled, is there any available data on the historical annual volume for these specific exams?

A2: We estimate 50 Police Physicals per year, which are included in the pre-employment exam numbers previously provided.
