



## Notice of Solicitation

The State of Minnesota, in cooperation with the MMCAP Infuse, a State of Minnesota governmental unit and service cooperative purchasing organization, has released a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the purchase of Medical Supplies. The Chief Procurement Officer for General Services (CPO-GS) has authorized that the State of Illinois and/or its governmental units may participate in the resulting contract(s) on a non-mandatory basis. This opportunity is being published in the Illinois Procurement Bulletin to only give notice to interested vendors; you must obtain the solicitation from the State of Minnesota's publication in State of Minnesota's publication in the Minnesota Supplier Portal. The purpose of this RFP is to establish Master Agreements with qualified Offerors to provide services related to Medical Supplies for all Participating Entities. The objective of this RFP is to obtain best value and achieve more favorable pricing than is obtainable by an individual state or local government entity because of the collective volume of potential purchases by numerous state and local government entities. The Master Agreement(s) resulting from this procurement shall be extended to state governments (including departments, agencies, institutions), institutions of higher education, political subdivisions (i.e. school districts, counties, cities, etc., the District of Columbia, territories of the United States, and other eligible entities subject to approval of the individual state procurement director and compliance with applicable statutory and regulatory provisions.

MMCAP anticipates entering into agreements for an initial four (4)-year term with an option of up to thirty-six (36) months of extension(s) in increments determined by MMCAP, in compliance with Minnesota law. Contract vendors must submit an annual certification that they are still compliant with the mandatory minimum requirements and technical specifications of the RFP.

The resulting Master Agreement contract(s) will provide Participating Entities with access to Medical Supplies.
