The Bidder shall submit its firm fixed unit prices for the Goods set forth in the Bid and described in the IFB on each of the following form(s) titled SCHEDULE OF QUANTITIES AND PRICES.

The estimated quantities shown on each of the SCHEDULE OF QUANTITIES AND PRICES are based on the best information available at the time the IFB was issued, and are used for the purpose of evaluating the Bids. LACMTA does not represent, expressly or by implication, that the actual quantities used in performing the Services will equal the estimated quantities.

In the case of items for which a fixed dollar amount predetermined by LACMTA has already been entered on the SCHEDULE OF QUANTITIES AND PRICES, the dollar amount entered shall be binding on all Bidders as the price for such item; said dollar amount shall not be revised unless LACMTA directs a Change in the Services affecting the item to which said dollar amount relates.

Unit prices, lump sum prices, and or other values must be entered in the appropriate spaces provided in each of the SCHEDULE OF QUANTITIES AND PRICES. Unit prices must be multiplied by the estimated quantity shown and the total inserted in the "Extended Price" column. The "Extended Prices" must be added together in arriving at the "Grand Total Basis of Award". The Grand Total Basis of Award shall be for the completion and acceptance of all Goods and Services listed in the SCHEDULE OF QUANTITIES AND PRICES as required by the Contract.

The unit prices must conform to their respective requirements and parameters as specified in each of the Scope of Services/Technical Requirements. They also must be inclusive of **all costs** for the Services specified in other Contract Documents, including the proportional costs for overhead, profit, all applicable taxes, tariffs, customs, import fees, insurance and other expenses of the Contractor, Subcontractors, and Suppliers of all tiers.

Should any unit price be left blank, the Bid will be considered non-responsive unless the blank item can be calculated from the information available (i.e., unit price can be determined by dividing the total price by the estimated quantity).

Should any total price be left blank, the Bid may be considered non-responsive unless the blank item can be calculated from the information available (i.e., total price can be determined by multiplying the unit price by the estimated quantity).
